## Our fees

The summer school fee is £2,245 with accommodation and £1,495 without accommodation. Fees for all students include lunch (Monday to Friday), course materials, use of specialist filming equipment and facilities, field trips, a welcome event, and end of school gala buffet. ## About our course

The University of Lincoln is located in the heart of one of the world's great historic cathedral cities. Lincoln Cathedral dominates the city at the top of Steep Hill and celebrated as one of the finest medieval landmarks in Europe. Together with Lincoln Castle and the cobbled Bailgate, it is a reminder of the city's long and fascinating history. This includes a long-standing involvement with the film industry and the City of Lincoln has been used a number of times for the production of feature films such as *Possession*, *The Young Victoria* and *The Da Vinci Code*.

The University of Lincoln is situated about 130 miles north of London. The Times newspaper refers to Lincoln as

having effected 'the most dramatic transformation of any university in recent times', with more than £200 million having been spent on building a stunning modern campus in the heart of a beautiful and ancient small city.

The Lincoln School of Film and Media offers a creative community of experienced staff, strong industry links and inspiring visiting speakers. Students in the School have access to industry-standard facilities and many academic staff are current media practitioners who are engaged with professional bodies, such as the Royal Television Society, the British Society of Cinematographers and the British Association of Film, Television and Screen Studies, ensuring that the course content is informed by the latest industry developments.

- > Producing your own mini documentary exploring the realities of British life at a time of great change.
- > A copy of your own documentary film for you to take away.
- > A chance to visit the historic Lincoln Castle and Lincoln Cathedral.
- > A certificate of attendance and participation presented to all those that complete this year's Summer School.

#### Who should attend:

- > The summer school will suit students who are interested in documentary at whatever level they are at, from being about to take undergraduate or postgraduate courses in film or media production at university to those already engaged in media production but who wish for an intense specialised opportunity to explore the act of documenting.
