Creative Futures

Summer Schools for students aged 16 - 19

Are you creative, an aspiring architect, designer, or budding performer or filmmaker? Are you thinking about a future in the creative and cultural industries and how higher education might make this possible?

This summer the University of Lincoln are offering a series of 6 summer schools for you to choose from. These courses are suitable for students in years 11 – 13 (or equivalent). Bursaries are also available for eligible students. Through a series of hands on activities and workshops you will explore what it is like to study creative subjects at University. Each 5-day summer school will run from 9.30 to 4.30, Monday to Friday.

Discovering Design, 15 – 19 July

This week is broken down into a series of hands-on taster workshops based around design disciplines of product design, communications design and interior design, and will develop your confidence and explore your creative identity.

Fashion & Millinery Experience, 15 – 19 July

This course aims to provide students with an understanding of key fashion concepts, and draw up customer profiles. Students will be introduced to fashion illustration and the basics of manipulating a head to toe look and the process involved.

Contemporary Dance, 22 – 26 July

A taster of a University dance course, experience practical, professional training with daily technique classes in different styles, choreographic and creative workshops and an end of week sharing performance for family and friends.

Acting and Stage Combat, 22 – 26 July

Learn the essential techniques for acting and stage combat, as well as key performance skills to build confidence in yourself and the ability to perform on stage and in everyday life. You will also be able to take a qualification in Unarmed Combat.

Architecture of the Future, 29 July – 2 August

This short course is a fantastic opportunity for those aiming to advance their knowledge and skills in the field of spatial design. It will help produce a portfolio of creative work needed when applying for undergraduate courses in disciplines such as architecture, construction and urban design.

Future Filmmakers, 29 July – 2 August

Do you want to be the next YouTube sensation? Using your own smartphone you will develop, film and edit your own short film and then learn how to upload this to YouTube and other social media channels.
